

# 7. Roads and Pavements, Traffic and Transport

11 respondents indicated there were things they could not do because they do not have transport. They were then asked to indicate what they could not do. Their responses included finding work, recycling, shopping further afield, travel for young people going out, visiting other locations.

The 149 households with bicycle riders were asked to describe any problems they encountered using a bicycle on the Parish's roads. 70 of these households gave 76 responses to this additional question. These were:
