

2. Housing

The response from those who disagreed with any policy statement are covered by the following:

- * Settlement boundaries should not be breached.
- * Backland development should only be permitted within settlement boundaries.
- * Any development must be subject to appropriate scale, character, density, access and no adverse impact on the neighbourhood.
- * The character of the Parish should be kept as it is.
- * Affordable housing is inappropriate if it is remote from transport and amenities.
- * Settlement boundaries need to be flexible if the village is to take its fair share of new housing.

Two additional questions were asked on housing and the responses on these were as follows
